
Workforce Origin

Clarence

Of those employed within the Clarence council area, Clarence residents make up about 51 per cent of the workforce.


The Clarence workforce also includes residents of Glenorchy (13 per cent), Hobart (10 per cent) and Sorell (8 per cent).



Glenorchy

Of those employed within the Glenorchy council area, Glenorchy residents make up about 39 per cent of the workforce.


The Glenorchy workforce also includes residents of Clarence (17 per cent), Hobart (13 per cent) and Brighton (10 per cent).



Hobart

Of those employed within the Hobart council area, Hobart residents make up the lowest proportion of its own workforce (35 per cent) out of the four Greater Hobart councils.


The Hobart workforce also includes residents of Clarence (20 per cent), Glenorchy (16 per cent) and Kingborough (14 per cent).



Kingborough

Of those employed within the Kingborough council area, Kingborough residents make up the highest proportion of its own workforce (66 per cent) out of the four Greater Hobart councils.

The Kingborough workforce also includes residents of Hobart (11 per cent), Huon Valley (7 per cent) and Clarence (7 per cent).



Greater Hobart

Overall, 83 per cent of the Greater Hobart workforce are residents within the Greater Hobart area.

Of those employed within the Greater Hobart area, Hobart and Clarence residents make up the highest proportion of the workforce (24 per cent each) followed by Glenorchy (19 per cent) and Kingborough (16 per cent).
